

CPS Defense (The Parental Shield)

The goal here is Defensive Transparency.

1. Please write out your full story onto any type of text file.

Chronologically list the CPS interaction. Include any threats made by caseworkers or failure to provide a warrant.

Dates are important!

Start with the first time the (county name)CPS/DFS became involved.

Include names and titles of all involved.

The child(ren) involved, can be identified by mychild1, my child2, etc..

Please include any specific statements or actions that were made that "stuck out" to you and anything else you believe may help your case. Everything is evidence. A caseworker's refusal to answer a question is evidence.

Once you are done writing and have checked it over to make sure it is complete, save it.

2. Sign up for a Gab.ai account.

Our platform chose to team up with Gab Ai because a few of us were impressed by its knowledge. Knowledge of the laws, the hidden laws not known to many, and the corruption of the system. You will need to sign up for an account at www.gab.ai. For one month's use, it is about \$20.00. (but once you use it, you may want to keep it longer, the choice is yours) Once you have made your user name, log in details and completed your payment you can log out.

3. Go back to Website.

Go to Foundational Justice website's and use The CPS Defender Case Analyzer. Fill in the simple details and then copy and paste your story into the box. Once this is done, click the submit button. In moments your results will be ready for you.

4. Get your results.

Log back into your Gab.ai account and your recommendations will be ready for you.

This is really just the start of seeing the advantages of using AI. Your analysis may identify potential violations and wrongdoings that were done against you, explaining other things you may not have even noticed. It can give you a plan of action to do, drafts to form up, etc. Copy and paste all of your information, and keep it where you can refer to it. Copy the drafts on separate files for organized form making. This is the start of your fight to get your child(ren)

back. Now you know what you can do. Keyword is CAN. Once you feel you are ready to go into that courtroom and calmly defend your case, file away!

If you have any question regarding how to do this or that, what if.. ask GAB. It will tell you. Sometimes it may tell you using long words you do not understand. If that happens simply respond with, "could you please explain that in simpler terms?" And it will. You can now ask it anything. Alternates for anything, a different plan, an updated plan, when given more information, whatever you need. You have the knowledge right under your fingertips, type away. You can do the same things the attorneys do and then some.

This is the personal advantage if you choose to go "pro se." (be your own lawyer) With today's technology it is more possible than it has ever been. Going "pro se" is your self-help ability to file your own motions personalized for your family. AI can also help you get prepared, mentally/physically. All with the focused goal of getting your child(ren) back. You will see for yourself, this Ai is different. It is not biased, it is not limited, it is not censored, it knows Truth, it is 100% American Made.

An attorney could do it for you, if you have the money they require for payment. Most of us don't. That is what "pro se" is all about. If you do chose to represent yourself, Gab provides draft language that allows you to present your case with clarity and precision often prioritized by legal professionals.

Recommendations for the use of Ai;

Have Gab draft a formal "Demand for Discovery" to CPS. You need every scrap of paper they have, including the initial "anonymous" tip. This template when copied & pasted onto your states "blank filing page" becomes a self help tool for you to receive every record CPS has collected in your case. You can be your own attorney and file for this, as soon as you print it out. Once you get all the information "they" have, it will help you to have a bigger defense.

The Records Request: Ask AI for a template for a "Demand for Incident Reports." CPS often takes kids based on "anonymous tips." Demand the specific documentation of the allegation, not just the removal.

Violation of Due Process argument: You could file a motion in the family court demanding the state prove the "Emergency" that justified taking the children. If there was no warrant, it's a 4th Amendment violation.

The 14th Amendment Shield: Do not let the parent talk to CPS without this instruction: “Unless you have a warrant or an immediate life-safety emergency, you are not entering this home.”

Administrative FOIA: Use the AI Agent to draft a state-specific Public Records/Freedom of Information request. Force them to turn over the “Worker Notes.” CPS workers often write things in notes that they dare not repeat in court. This would be a total must-have!

The Courtroom Tactic: File the AI-drafted “Motion for Immediate Return” based on the lack of Evidence of Abuse. Force them to show proof in court, where they cannot hide behind “policy.”
